

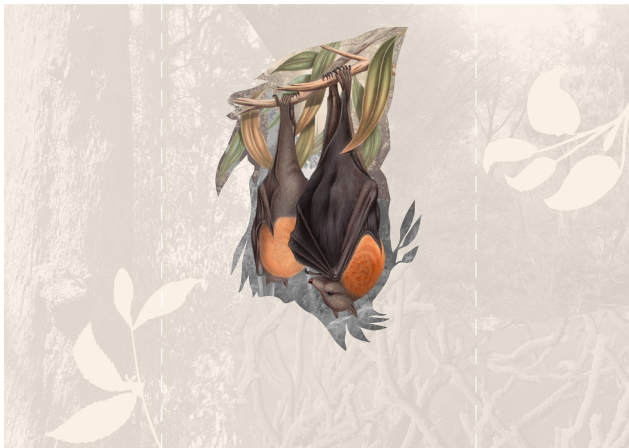
REMAKING HOME

with
GRACIA AND LOUISE

Gracia and Louise are artists and wildlife carers. At their home in Melbourne, they look after small native mammals including Grey-headed flying foxes. Look around and you will see that their art installation depicts a pocket of restored eucalyptus forest – the habitat of the Grey-headed flying fox. When *The remaking of things* opened as part of this exhibition, six Grey-headed flying fox pups who had been in the artists' care for many months were released to join the flying fox colony on the banks of the Birrarung. Now it's your turn to make a collage celebrating this wonderful creature and its habitat.

You will need:

- Scissors and a glue stick
- Base card and collage sheet

COLLAGE SHEET

- 1 Cut or tear shapes of different plant details to create a home for your flying fox from the collage sheet.
- 2 Spend time arranging the cut-outs on the card to create an interesting composition.
- 3 Notice that the paper scraps may be interesting to include in your collage.
- 4 When you are happy with the arrangement, glue the shapes to the base card.
- 5 Take your finished collage home to display.
